Letters are going home this evening regarding parent teacher evenings so please return the slips to school as soon as possible.

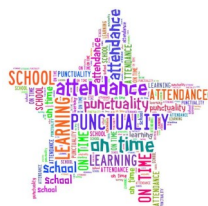
