

Class 1

English: This term we will be looking at 3 different books. The first book we will look at is A Walk in London – we will be using this book to help us write a factual blog about London landmarks. Next we will look at The Queen’s Hat – we will use this book as inspiration for Acrostic poems, Limericks and a News story. Lastly this term we will be looking at The True Story of The 3 Little Pigs! – We will use this story to look at fairy tales and write our own version of our favourite.

We will continue to develop our reading skills this term. We will investigate vocabulary, use evidence and reasoning to infer what the author means, along with continuing to use our phonics to help us segment and blend together words we are unsure of.

Physical Education: Gymnastics – this term we will learn to master basic movements, including jumping and rolling, as well as developing balance, agility and co-ordination.

Religious Education: We will be learning about Judaism this term. We will learn about the creation story and what it means to belong to the Jewish faith.

History: Our first history topic will be learning about significant individuals that have made a difference to our world, national and internationally. We will then move on a local history study and learn about Queen Victoria and the role she played on our Island.

PSHE: This term we will be focussing on:

- Feelings and emotions
- Growing and changing
- Valuing difference.

These lessons will be done through discussion, role play and written work.

Summer 1

Mathematics: This term we will be focussing on:

- Solving missing number problems and using the inverse to help us.
- Multiplication and division.
- Fractions. Recognise, find name and write fractions $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{2}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ of a length, shape or quantity.
- Position and direction.

STEAM

Science: This term we will be learning about plants. We will investigate the structure of a plant and what it needs to survive. We will then learn about seasonal changes and the weather in the UK.

Design Technology: Textiles – we will be designing a new medical bag for Florence Nightingale. We will then go on to design and make a Victorian toy.

Computing: Programming – we will learn about early programming concepts. We will explore using individual commands, with others and as part of a computer program. We will identify what each floor robot command does and use that knowledge to start predicting the outcome of programs. We will introduce them to the early stages of program design through the introduction of algorithms.

EXPLORE: (Curriculum support)

Geography: We will continue our learning about the 4 countries of the UK and the surrounding seas. We will focus on the capital cities of these countries, particularly London.
