Stenbury Federation London Trip – Thursday 8th July

Dear Parents and Carers

16th June 2021

Exciting news ahead...the London trip is nearly here!

The remaining balance is now due for this trip. We have managed to secure a good price for transport and therefore the remaining balance to pay is only £20 (if you have already paid the deposit). The total cost of £30 needs to be paid please by Friday 2nd July.

We will be leaving Ryde Pier Head (change of boat) at 7.45am sharp. Please meet us at the Pier Head for 7.20am. If you need support getting your child there in the morning, please let me know. We will then join the coach in Portsmouth for a 9am pick up. The journey time to London is approximately 2 hours.

We will be dropped off on Victoria Embankment. From there we will travel up The Embankment to The Globe Theatre on foot. From there we will catch an Uber boat along the river Thames on a return journey. We will stop & have lunch, either at McDonalds (money will be needed for this) or bring a packed lunch. After lunch we will walk through central London looking at the different sites: House of Parliament, Horse Guards Parade, changing of The Guard and Buckingham Palace. We will then walk back through Regents Park to meet the coach at the Victoria Embankment for a 6pm pick up.

We are hoping to catch the 8.20pm Fast Cat back to Ryde Pier Head, where you will be waiting to collect your child. We will keep you informed if there are any changes to this time.

The children will need to have appropriate clothing for the trip: If it is warm, then sunscreen & a hat is necessary, sensible & comfortable shoes & clothing (no strappy tops or flip flops). Leaver's Hoodies can be worn if they so wish. They will need plenty of drinks & snacks to get them through the day. Spending money will be at parent's discretion, but your child will be responsible for their money & mobile phone at all times (if they wish to bring it to take pictures).

If you have any questions or queries please either email the school or speak to Mrs Boakes or Mr Smith.

If your child is entitled to Free School Meals a packed lunch can be provided for the day from school if you so wish. We will need to know in advance so please let us know no later than Thursday 1 July. Thank you.
